# The RTP Update Process

- 2030 Traffic Forecast
  - Based on *anticipated* regional growth
- Unconstrained Improvement Strategy
  - Recommended Improvements needed to maintain *2004* LOS Policies
- Constraints Analysis
  - Determine *reduced* scope of improvements based on potential impacts, funding, & community acceptance

# The RTP Update Process

- Constrained Improvement Strategy
  - ***Only*** recommended improvements that are ***feasible*** to implement given constraints
- Alternative Strategies
  - Multi-modal, “Complete Streets”, TDM/TSM, “Sustainable Communities Strategies”, etc.
