**ADDENDUM #1**

**Issued: July 11, 2008**

**Purpose of RFP Addendum #1.** The Request for Proposals (RFP) states in several areas that construction of the project(s), as well as the construction management services, will be funded in part with Federal funds. As stated in the RFP, all Federal requirements will apply, including all requirements related to administration of Federal transportation funds that are authorized through Caltrans Local Assistance.

This Addendum transmits copies of the Amador County Transportation Commission's newly-approved Quality Assurance Program. A Quality Assurance Program (QAP) is a sampling and testing program that provides assurance that the materials and workmanship incorporated in each highway construction project are in conformance with the contract specifications. The main elements of a Quality Assurance Program are acceptance testing and independent assurance sampling and testing.

*The QAP does not modify any of the requirements that are applicable to the project based upon Caltrans Local Assistance requirements, and does not change the Scope of Services listed in the RFP.* However, because of Caltrans recent attention to the QAP requirement, and ACTC's recent approval of a new QAP, Addendum #1 is being issued to ensure complete understanding of this requirement on the part of potential proposers.
